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## USING THE DOMI-NOTES GAME – Leader

Print both sheets **on heavy card-stock** (*in full color if possible!*) and cut the tiles apart.

You will have 36 tiles.

Play this just like you play dominoes; if you need a refresher on domino-playing, check the rule books!

In this case, you will need to play with no more than 4 players.

- Turn all the tiles face down in the middle of the table.
- Each player draws four tiles and does not let the other players see his/her tiles.
- Put the remaining tiles in a draw-pile.
- If someone has the double-blank, they put it in the middle to start; the player to his/her right goes next; continue around the table.
- If no one has the double-blank, go to the double “do”... then to double “re”... etc. until someone can start the game.
- As in dominoes, the next person plays on one side of the tile that is played first, matching the note-names.
- If a player can not play (has no tile with a matching end), he must draw from the draw-pile. [To keep it simple, let them only draw one tile on each turn they can not play, then move on to the next player to the right.]
- **The first person to run out of tiles wins.**

The board should look something like this:
